



## **2 to 3 School**

**2 to 3** will probably be your child's first experience of school and it is very important that it is a happy one. We aim to provide a cosy and caring environment for every child, one which they will find stimulating to help develop their confidence, skills and knowledge.

When you and your child arrive at **2 to 3** it will be set up with various activities. Do look at these together and help to settle your child in. The activities are planned to cover a wide range of the curriculum and to help each child develop independence and understanding of themselves and others.

Here are some of the activities your child will be doing:

Drawing, painting, printing, cutting, collage, modelling with different materials – clay, junk, dough and plasticine, sand and water play, cooking,  
Counting, sorting and matching games, imaginative toys – dolls house, farm, zoo, fort, garage, real-life corner-shop, house, hospital etc. listening to stories, rhymes and poems, music including singing, band and dancing, nature activities and outdoor play every day (weather permitting).

We work on a series of themes each term and plan many of our activities around these. Children are able to move around the room freely, exploring different areas. They are encouraged to extend their knowledge and spend more time on each activity. We like all children to use their time constructively at **2 to 3**.

We are very lucky to have an excellent musician on our full-time staff at **2 to 3**. Barbara is an accomplished pianist and her presence enables us to give the children a chance to express themselves through singing and playing musical instruments on a regular basis.

The children help 'tidy up' each day and we have singing, circle time and a story. On Thursdays they may bring a toy to school to 'show and tell'.

Juice and biscuits are provided each afternoon.

Our emphasis in all things is to give the children a happy introduction to school life. If you would like to know more or discuss the appropriate term for your child to start with us, please do not hesitate to get in touch. We look forward to having your child at **2 to 3** in the near future.
